



She was a leader in the photography world in Maine for over 25 years and one of the most successful business photographers in the industry. Ever the optimist, Gail's love for her children, family and friends, and life itself, led to

multiple odds beating chances at life with each successive diagnostic setback. A tri-athlete, Gail's competitive spirit found her on many triathlon venues over the years including "Tri for A Cure", initially as a competitor, and later as a photographer and spectator. Countless weddings and family portraits are where she made her artistic mark, capturing her client's natural beauty, representing their essence, as well as reflecting their appearance. Her portrait work can be found in homes throughout New England. A member of the MPPA for over 20 years, she was a speaker at conventions and an inspiration and teacher to many New England Photographers.

Marjorie L. Clark, 89, of Brunswick, died Monday, Feb. 4, 2013, at Mid Coast Hospital, with her family by her side. During World War II, she worked as a decoder for the U.S. State Department in Washington, D.C. She took great pride in that she was on duty and decoded the message from Adm. William Halsey to President Harry Truman, stating that the war in the



Pacific theater was over. After the war, she and her husband, James Clark, photographer and co-founder of the MPPA, settled in Augusta. Together they operated the James Clark Studio for 50 years. He is currently a Contributing Editor and writer for the Professional Photographer Magazine and PPMag.com. Don is known in

the industry as a master of studio lighting & has taught programs on studio portrait lighting in 27 states & the Bahamas.

Don has won many awards in competition including NHPPA Photographer-of-the-Year, Best of Show, Highest Scoring Print, numerous Courts of Honor, Kodak Gallery awards and ASP State Elite awards. On the national level, Don has 13 Loan Collection images (all portraits) and 5 consecutive PPA Photographer-of-the-Year awards, including Diamond. In 2010 he received the Imaging Excellence Award from PPA. Don has judged at 20 state level print competitions. Bernie's photography awards include numerous prestigious Kodak Gallery Awards for excellence in photography, two Fuji Masterpiece Awards for excellence in wedding photography, five Maine State Court of Honors for best Wedding Portrait, Digital Image and Illustrative Image. Nylora Bruleigh, CPP has owned and operated her portrait studio "Photography by Nylora" since 1996. While pregnant with her daughter in 2003, it became clear to her that she had found a new source of inspiration for her work. Pat's program will cover several different lighting concepts from parabolic scoops, umbrellas, soft boxes, and how to customize these implements to meet your photographic needs without undue expense. He will have samples of his varied work through the years on hand and will gladly discuss, if prodded, some of his controversial views in regards to the industry today. This program will have something for every skill level whether you're just learning your craft or are a seasoned professional with a bevy of award medals.

Pat Michaud began his photography career by learning how to develop film and process prints as part of a college photography class. He concentrated on the darkroom process for almost 2 years before picking up a camera, developing and printing exclusively for his college public relations department.

A graduate of Ricker College with a B.A. in Journalism, Pat photographed his first wedding in 1982 and opened a full service photography business in 1986. Some of his past commercial clients include Architecture Magazine, Saab America, Cuddledown, American Honda, Irving, Sotheby's, Young's Furniture and several Portland law firms. He has had work displayed at Disney World and has given lighting programs in Maine and New Hampshire. He has received the Art Leather award, the Fuji Masterpiece portrait award and has served as President of the Maine Professional Photographers Association.

Pat's lighting has been described by his mentor, Jay Stock, www.jaystock.com, as the most innovative style he's ever seen using a minimum of equipment.




