Statement of Purpose

The Maine Professional Photographers Association (MPPA) established the Award and Recognition Program in 2009, that mirrors the national (PPA) degree program, to recognize photographic excellence and service to the photographic community (and self) through volunteerism and education.

It is our hope that these awards will serve to inspire new and current members to become and stay active in the professional community, to continue learning and improving through education and attendance at photographic events, and to recognize those individuals whose photographic excellence and service are exemplary.

MPPA Awards

There are three (3) awards that can be achieved as follows:

Maine Photographic Excellence Award - Awarded for superior photographic competence through photographic competition, advanced education, and service to the profession. 25 Points earns a *gold medallion with a green ribbon*, with a bar earned for each additional 25 points. For each 25 points, 13 must be Image Points and the remaining 12 can be from any point category.

Maine Fellowship Award - Awarded to recognize service, fellowship, and continuing education. 25 Points earns a *silver medallion with a purple ribbon*, with a bar earned for each additional 25 points. For each 25 points, 5 points must be Membership Points, 13 must be Education Points, and the remaining 7 can be from any point category.

Maine Distinguished Colleague Award - This award is reserved for the MPPA to bestow upon a member who has gone above and beyond expectations in their service to association and the photographic profession. The individual may or may not have already received other awards, honors, and degrees. This award is for an individual nominated by the membership or identified by the ARC or Board whom the MPPA feels additional accolades are in order to recognize a member's continued exceptional service to the MPPA. It is not an award earned by accumulation of points like the other two, but is a special honor that the MPPA may bestow upon a deserving member. Medallions and bars that are issued as part of this award program are to be worn at all state, regional, and national functions. A certificate suitable for framing will be issued with each award.

Lobster Pin Incentive - The *Maine Photographic Excellence Award* and *Maine Fellowship Award* are accolades that may take considerable time and effort to achieve. As an added incentive to work hard, be involved, learn a lot, and earn points, we offer the "Lobster Pin incentive". Those members that accumulate 12 points in a calendar year (regardless of category) will be bestowed the Lobster Pin. You can earn one every year, and it can be worn on your clothing or fastened to your Photographic Excellence or Maine Fellowship ribbons.

General Information

The Award and Recognition Committee (ARC) - The Award and Recognition Committee Chairperson shall be appointed by the President at the first meeting of the calendar year. The ARC shall consist of not less than 3 members and shall meet at least once a year prior to the annual convention to review records and prepare a list of eligible award recipients. The Award and Recognition Committee Chairperson shall make all necessary arrangements for the procurement of the awards (medallions, certificates, etc). A list of all those who qualify for an Award shall be presented to the Board for final approval.

Membership Requirements - Any individual wishing to participate in the *Maine Professional Photographers Association's Award & Recognition Program* must be a current member in good standing with MPPA at the time points being claimed are earned to be eligible for awards. Membership must be in consecutive years. If a lapse in membership occurs, all previously accumulated points are NOT forfeited. The member, upon renewal, must supply their own copy of their annual list of approved credits. The Award and Recognition Committee cannot be held responsible for records of lapsed members.

Earning an Award - The program will run on an annual basis. No credits will be awarded for any achievements prior to establishment on January 1, 2009. Members are responsible for keeping track of the points they accumulate during the year. The *Maine Photographic Excellence Award* and the *Maine Fellowship Award* both rely on members accumulating points. There are four (4) types of points that can be earned: Image, Education, Membership, & General. Points can only be awarded to individuals, not to studios. A point can only be used once in any one category (no "double dipping"). For example, if you earn a point for attending a photographic seminar, you must decide whether to use it towards your Fellowship Award as an "education" point OR if you'd like to put it towards your Photographic Excellence Award as a "general" point; it cannot be used in both places.

Deadline to Submit Points - All members must submit their *point summary form* each year by **FEBRUARY 1st** (online at: maineppa.com/awards-recognition). We can not guarantee that any awards or incentive earned in the previous calendar year will be presented if forms are submitted after the deadline. You MAY, however, submit your points at any time during the year and any awards earned will be presented the following year at convention (not to include the lobster pin incentive).

Awards Presentation - ALL awards shall be presented annually at the MPPA Awards Banquet at Convention. If a recipient does not attend the banquet, the Award shall be presented at the next monthly meeting that the recipient attends.

Point Categories

IMAGE POINTS

A maximum of 7 points can be used towards Image Points in one calendar year; additional points earned through image competition may be used as "other" general category points.

Entering a minimum of two entries in MPPA image competition (including albums)	1 point
Each entry scoring a blue ribbon (score of 80 or above)	1 point
Receiving a "Category" Photographer/Image of the Year award (each category)	1 point
Each entry receiving a Judge's Choice award	1 point
Entry receives "Best of Show"	1 point
Receiving "Win Tracy Photographer of the Year"	3 points
Entry receives other award (Client Image, Creative Challenge, etc)	1 point

EDUCATION POINTS

A maximum of 7 points can be used towards Education Points in one calendar year; a maximum of 2 additional points earned through education may be used as "other" general category points, with a grand total of 9 points per calendar year. NOTE: Education Points can NOT be earned for college classes (or similar) for which you receive academic or other credit. Each photographic educational event attended (includes monthly/regular meetings)	1 point
MPPA, PPANE, or PPA Convention attendance (2-3 consecutive days)	2 points
Attendance at PPA Affiliate School (NEIPP, or similar, multi-day program)	2 points
Speaker at MPPA or other photographic program (1 hr minimum)	2 points

MEMBERSHIP POINTS

A maximum of 3 points can be used towards Membership Points in one calendar year; additional points earned through membership may be used as "other" general category points.

Membership (must have dues paid and remain active for entire calendar year)	1 point
Perfect attendance (attend all regular/monthly meetings & 1 day of convention)	1 point
Refer a new member to join MPPA (2 points per member)	2 points

Point Categories continued

GENERAL POINTS

Unlimited points; Member may request special consideration of other contributions to the association or professional growth in the photographic industry, per approval of committee with points to be determined. Must provide documentation.

Service on the MPPA Executive Board (1 st VP, 2 nd VP, Treasurer, or Secretary)	4 points
Service on the MPPA Board of Directors	2 points
State Rep to PPANE	1 point
Webmaster	3 points
Image Competition Chairperson	4 points
Image Competition Committee Member (for every 6 hours service)	1 point
Trade Show Chairperson	2 points
Other Committee Chairperson	2 points
Committee Member	1 point
Newsletter Editor	3 points
Convention Book Editor	2 points
Convention Hospitality	2 points

OTHER

Host Studio for MPPA seminar/meeting	1 point
Article published in MPPA newsletter	1 point
Mentor (assigned this role by MPPA Board for a member)	2 points
Distinguished Colleague Award recipient	1 point
Become certified through PPA (CPP)	2 points
Continued compliance with certification (each 5 year renewal to maintain CPP status)	1 point
Earn PPA Degree (M.Photog., Cr.Photog., or M.Artist)	5 points

If you earned 12 or more points this year, CONGRATULATIONS! You've earned a lobster pin!

For the *Maine Photographic Excellence Award* and *Maine Fellowship Award*, we will allocate your points to your benefit. We will total up your points from year to year, and let you know if you have earned an award. You must be a paid, current member in good standing to earn an award.
